CLOVER BUDS ANIMAL SHOW GUIDELINES:

- ▶ The **4-H Clover buds Program** is for youth between the ages five - seven years old on January 1 of the current calendar year. Youth must turn six years old during 2007 and have not passed their eighth birthday as of January 1, 2007 to be eligible.
- ▶ Clover buds exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H club or as an individual 4-H member by the MAY 1, 2007 enrollment deadline..
- ▶ All projects will receive the same premium (\$0.50) and a participation ribbon (non-competitively).
- ▶ The limit is ONE entry for the Clover buds Animal Show.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR CLOVERBUDS ANIMAL SHOW:

- ▶ Animals in the Clover buds Animal Show have the option be brought the day of the show and taken home after the show is over or brought on Wednesday and taken home at the end of the fair.
- ▶ However, if the Clover buds animal exhibited by the Clover buds 4-H member is also exhibited by a sibling who is a 4-H or FFA member (8 – 18 year old), the animal **MUST** abide by the guidelines within the (species) department/division.
LIVESTOCK STALL/PEN REQUEST FORM: Exhibitors of ANIMALS that remain on the fairgrounds the duration of the fair are REQUIRED to complete and submit request form to the UNL Extension Office, Fremont by office closing on Friday, July 20, 2007.
- ▶ Clover buds animal entries **MUST** abide by the following General Livestock/Animal Rules & Regulations found in this fair book.
 1. Care of Exhibits
 2. Livestock/Animal Health Requirements (according to the species/department/division)
 3. Dress Code for Livestock/Animal Exhibitors

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR CLOVER BUDS SWINE EXHIBITS:

- ▶ Clover buds 4-H members exhibiting SWINE must abide by the Swine Division Guidelines found in Department G / Swine Division.
- ▶ **QUALITY ASSURANCE REQUIREMENT:** Parents and/or older siblings of Cloverbuds exhibiting SWINE at the Dodge County Fair are required to be Quality Assurance (QA) or Pork Quality Assurance (PQA) certified by June 15, 2007 if swine are to be processed by Hormel Foods Corporation or Wiechman Pig Co Inc. following the fair.

4-H CLOVER BUDS PROGRAM INVOLVING LIVE ANIMALS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- ▶ Exhibition includes discussions with youth based on their knowledge of the care and raising of the animal.
- ▶ Exhibitors "show" in a non-competitive setting for participation only.
- ▶ Age, size, and temperament of animal projects must be appropriate for the exhibitor's age and size.
- ▶ Horse projects are NOT appropriate for this age group and are excluded in the Clover bud Division.

SUGGESTED GUIDELINES FOR ALL ANIMALS INCLUDING LIVESTOCK SPECIES (beef, sheep, dairy, swine):

1. The adult/teen volunteer to child ratio during Clover buds exhibitions of animals will be a minimum of 1:2 (ie. There will be one adult/teen volunteer present for every two Clover buds that are handling or exhibiting animals.) This applies to all animal projects.
2. Livestock animals should be no more than six months of age and no more than 350 pounds at time of show.
